### AGREED CONCLUSIONS

- Inauguration of TCT premises is scheduled for 13<sup>th</sup> of September 2019
- Information on the future Financial rules for the Transport Community was provided to the RSC Members. RSC Members will be duly informed about the process of adoption and the rules will be then submitted to RSC for formal endorsement.
- All RPs will communicate their timeline to provide their contribution to the 2019 TCT Budget, reduced by the amount to be transferred from the SEETO budget remainings, as previously agreed by the SEETO SC Chair. This information will be provided by RSC by the end of June 2019.
- RSC endorsed 3 pillar proposals of TCT action on rail, transport facilitation and road safety in view of Poznan Summit
  - Financial support of the EC TA in the amount of 2.5 mil EUR for the above mentioned TCT priority projects (TA and design) will be announced in Poznan. Potential further funding for investments under WBIF is being considered.
- Process of recruitment of Director and Deputy Director is about to be launched and will follow the principles agreed during the last SC Meeting. Recruitment of other officials will take place in parallel.
- The proposal to appoint Regional Party Coordinators has been accepted by all RPs
- Next RSC Meeting is provisionally planned to take place in the week starting the 07<sup>th</sup> of October 2019
