The Permanent secretariat has been informed that Serbia would be requesting that all vehicles (except those licenced in Serbia) entering in Serbia at Merdare CCP would be first registered at the Serbian liaison officer, posted in Pristina. The Permanent Secretariat is in close contact with the authorities in Belgrade and Pristina to assess (a) the correctness of the information (b) the reasons for taking it and (c) the consequences on traffic of this measure. More details will follow.

Data sources:

- One week ago data are average waiting times based on the official submission from 13th – 18th of April 2020
- Official data are sent by South East European Parties (SEEP) to Transport Community Secretariat every day at 14.00
- Waiting time calculations take into account inbound and outbound waiting times in both directions
