

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (17-21 august 2020)

### BORDER MONITORING

During the third week of August (17 – 21 August) waiting times have remained stable at most EU/WB6 BCPs that are currently being monitored. However, in Batrovci/Bajakovo and Kakavija/Ktismata waiting times were on a slightly increasing trend, while in Horgos/Roszke a significant improvement could be noted.

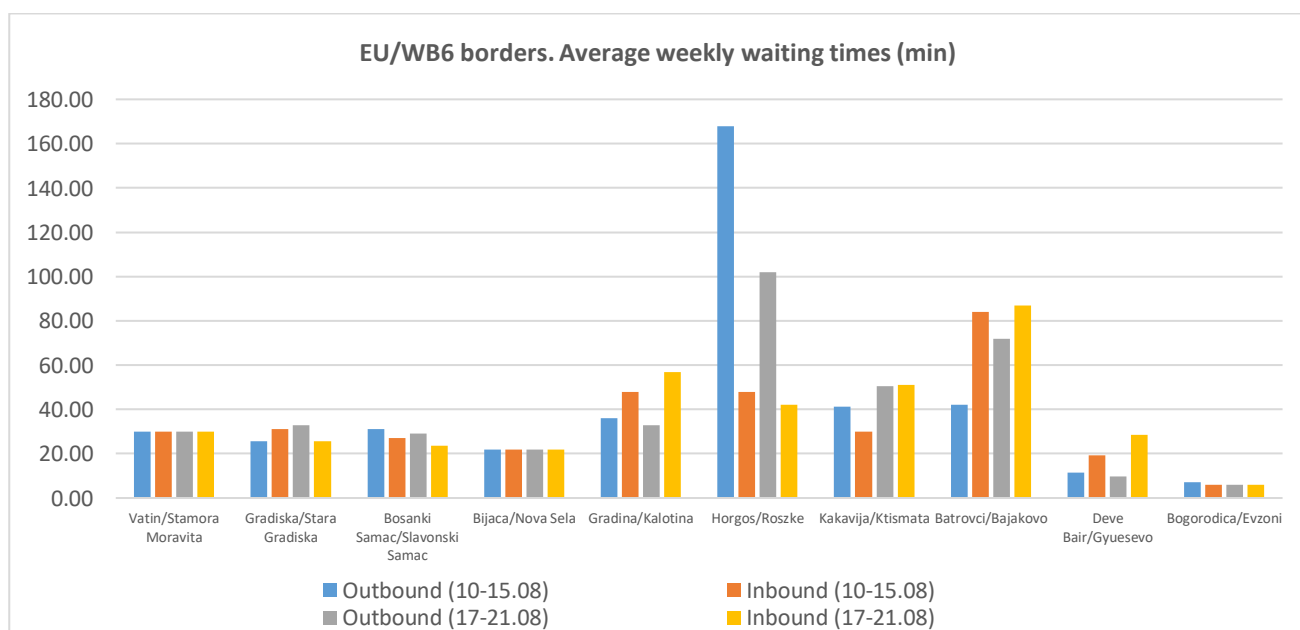


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
