


Monitoring waiting time at Western Balkans internal borders - July 2020

Since the Joint proposal prepared by TCT Permanent Secretariat and CEFTA Secretariat to facilitate the transport and trade of essential goods within the Western Balkans, we have been monitoring the waiting times at the borders in close cooperation with the respective authorities.

Daily monitoring has shown no major jams at Western Balkans internal borders during the past 2 months. During July, the waiting times across the region have remained almost at the level of the June times while the trend of time saving is still visible at Sremska Raca/Raca (SRB/BiH) on the inbound direction. The inbounds times show a slight increase within the 40-50 min range while the outbounds times show a sharp decrease in the range between 20-30 min towards waiting times between 40-50min. Such trends were expected due to the overall increase in traffic volumes and the seasonal passenger cars volumes.

1. WB6 Internal borders – Average Monthly Waiting Times (July 2020)


BCP/CCP Western Balkans 6 - internal borders Average Monthly Waiting Times (min) - July 2020
