Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (07th – 11th of September 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

Durimng the second week of September Batrovci/Bajakovo has replaced Horgos/Roszke as the busiest of all Border Crossing Points in the region, confirming its overall worsening trend. In Horgos/Roszke the decrease in waiting time on SRB-HUN direction was compensated by a significant increase on HUN-SRB side which is usually less crowded. Gradina/Kalotina seems to have returned on an improving trend, while no significant variations were recorded in the other Border Crossing Points under monitoring, as shown in the table below.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
