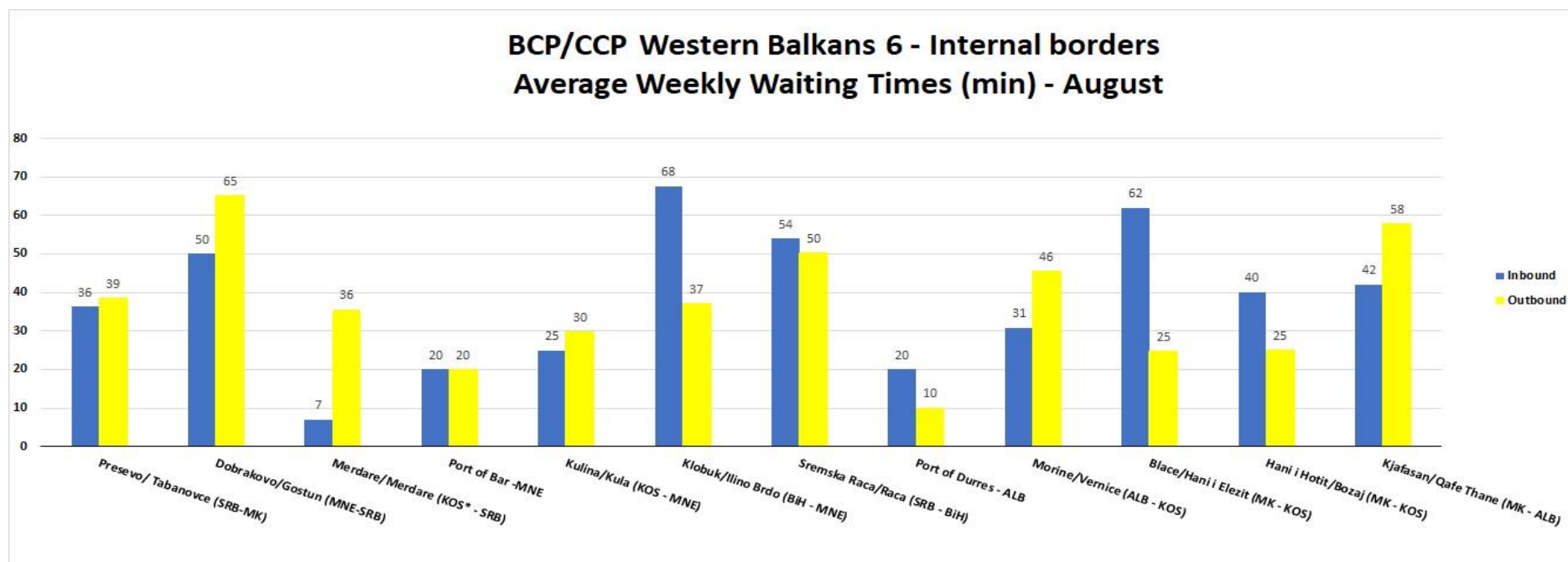


Monitoring waiting time at WB internal borders (July – August 2020)

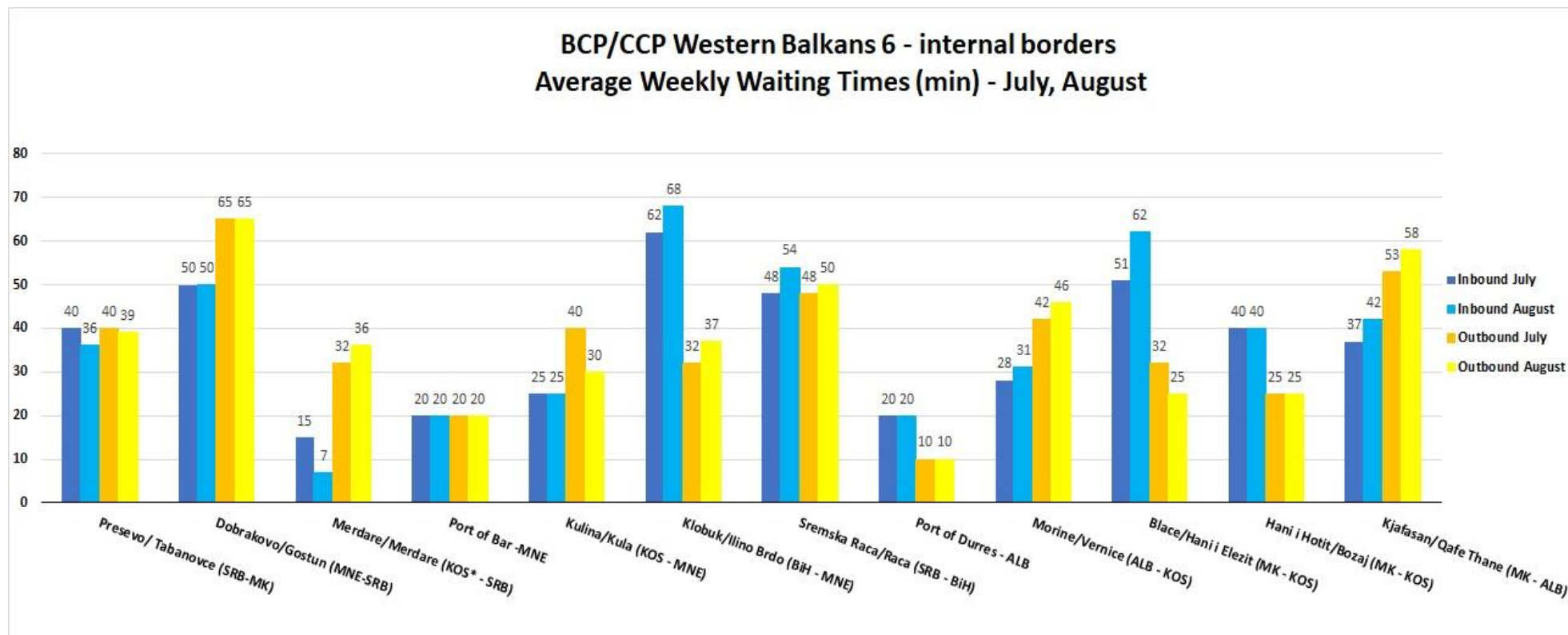
Since the Joint proposal prepared by TCT Permanent Secretariat and CEFTA Secretariat to facilitate the transport and trade of essential goods within the Western Balkans, we have been monitoring the waiting times at the borders in close cooperation with the respective authorities.

Daily monitoring has shown no major jams at Western Balkans internal borders during the past 2 months. During August, the waiting times across the region have remained almost at the level of July times. A slight improvement was noticed on for the Kulina/Kula BCP on the outbound direction. On the other hand, a slight worsening was noticed on the Blace/Hani i Elezit BCP on the inbound direction. The inbounds times show a slight increase within the 60-80 min range while the outbounds times show a sharp decrease in the range between 40-50 min range while there is an increase on the 30-40 min range.
