

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (14 – 18 September 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

During the third week of September the overall situation has remained stable at all EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region. The most important weekly variation was recorded in Horgos/Roszke, where an increase in waiting times on SRB-HUN direction was doubled by a comparable decrease in the opposite side.

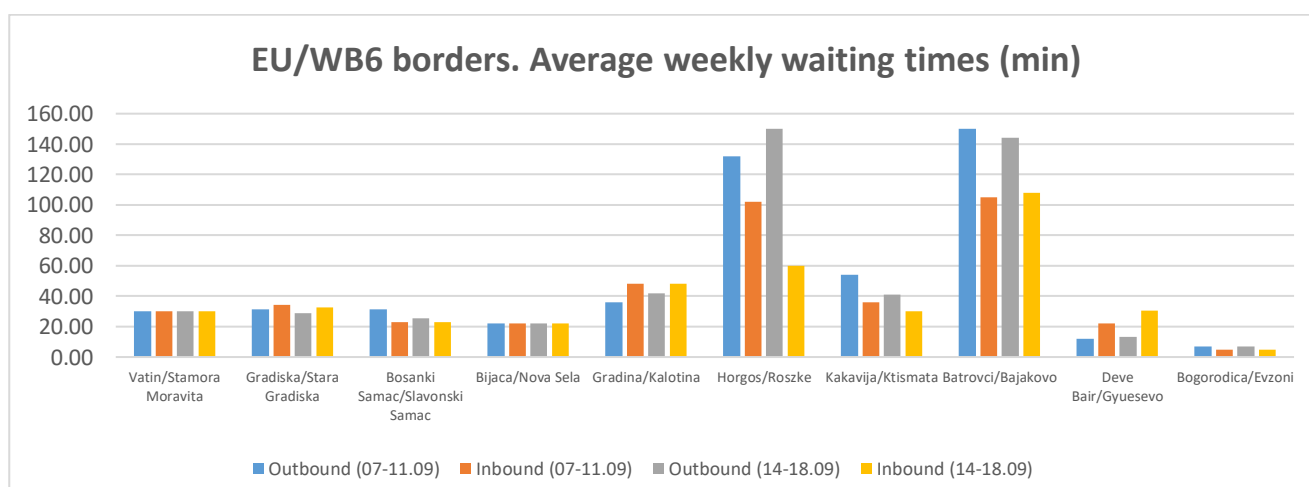


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
