

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (21 – 25 of September 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

The overall situation has remained stable at most EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region. Waiting times in Gradina/Kalotina have decreased, confirming the positive late summer trend. Another noticeable variation was recorded in Batrovci/Bajakovo with longer than usual waiting times being recorded on HR-SRB direction, while the situation got significantly better in the opposite side. Similar trend was observed in Kakavija/Ktismata as well.

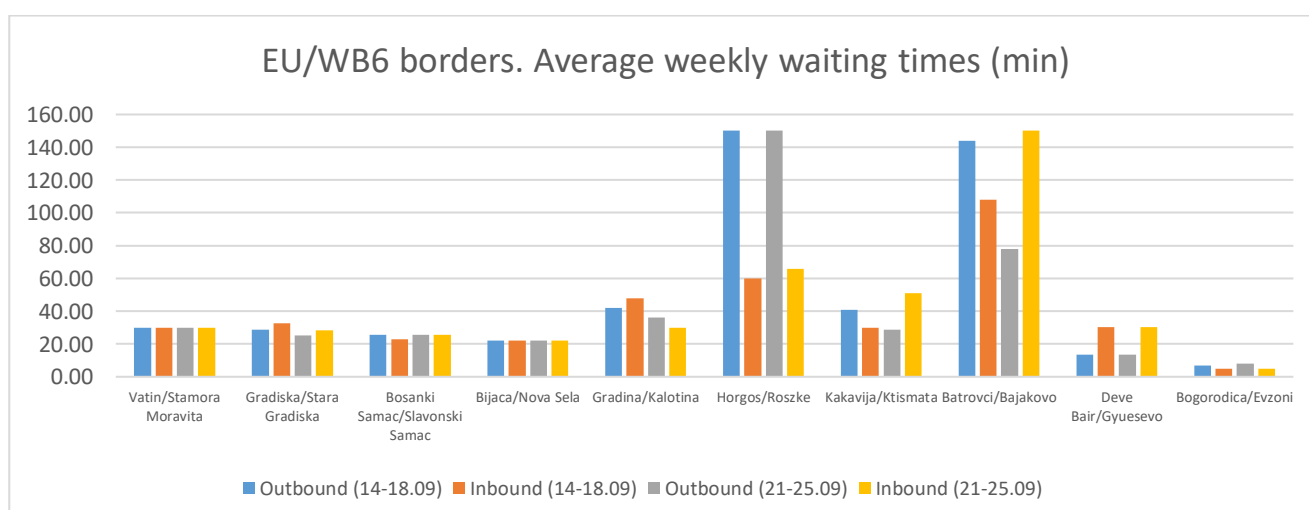


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
