

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (24-28 august 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

During the last week of August (24 – 28 August) waiting times have increased significantly in the most crowded BCP in the region (Batrovci/Bajakovo and Horgos/Roszke). Gradina/Kalotina remains on an improving trend while situation is more or less stable in the other monitored Border Crossing Points, as shown below.

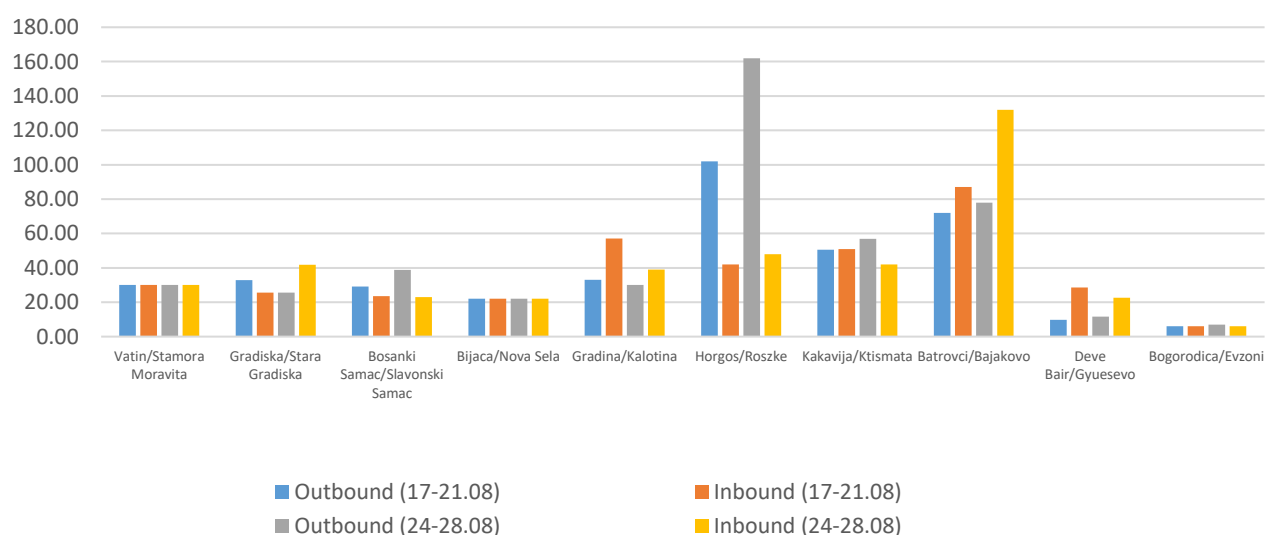


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
