

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (31 August – 04 September 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

The first week of September has come with increasing waiting times in Horgos/Roszke and Gradina/Kalotina. Batrovci/Bajakovo and Kakvija/Ktismata have also experienced significant increase in waiting time on the outbound direction, compensated by comparable decrease in the opposite side. No significant variations were recorded in the other Border Crossing Points under monitoring, as shown in the table below.

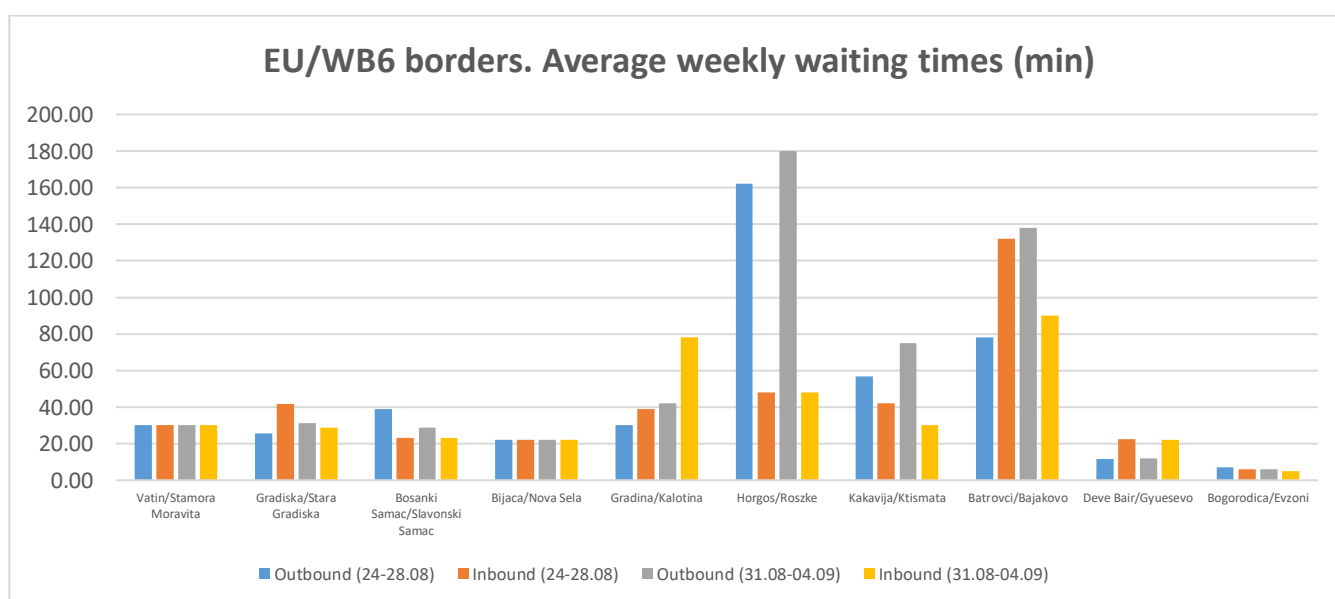


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
