

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (19 - 23 October 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

In the third week of October the situation improved in Kakavija/Ktismata after 2 consecutive weeks of prolonged waiting times but got worse in Horgos/Roszke who turned back to its usual 2 h + waiting on SRB – HUN direction.

For the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained rather stable.

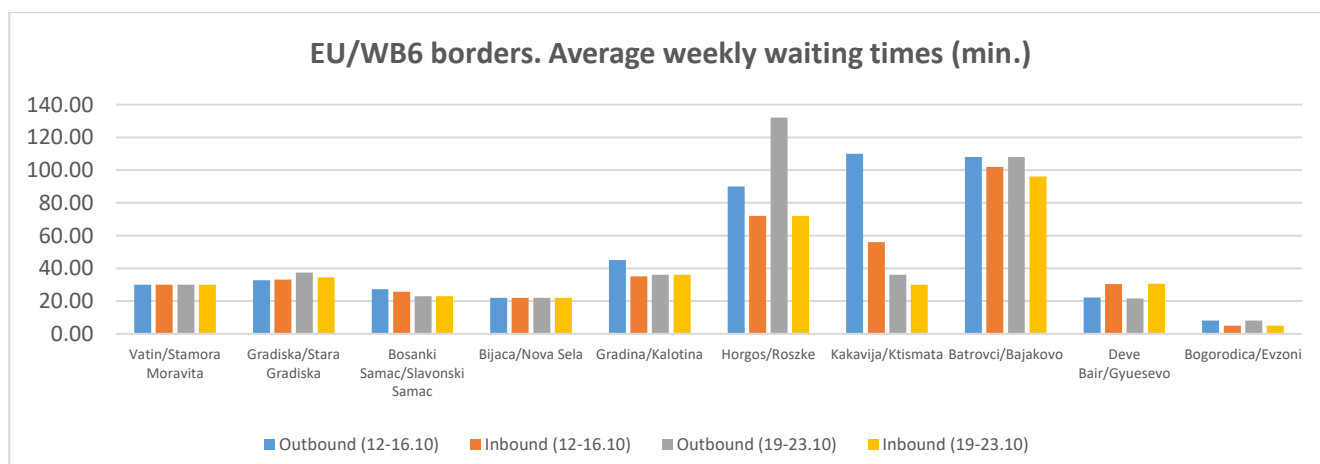


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
