

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (28 September – 02 October 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

During the last week of September, the waiting times in Horgos/Roszke have decreased in both directions. On the other side, Gradina/Kalotina went a bit worse while in Batrovci/Bajakovo the small decrease in waiting time on HR-SRB direction could not entirely compensate the significant increase registered for the SRB – HR route.

For the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained rather stable.

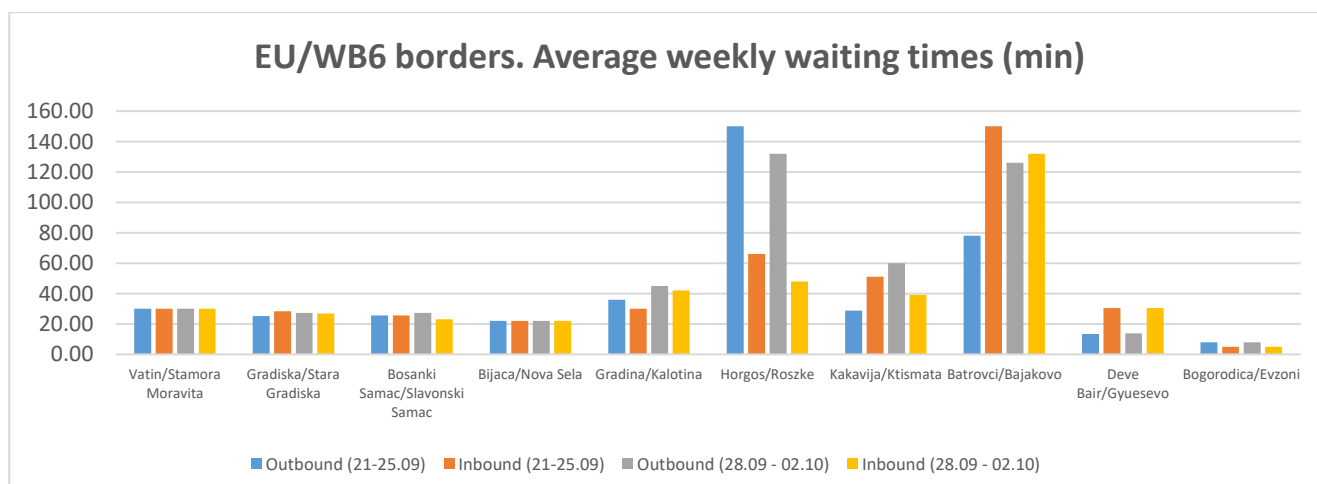


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
