Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (16 - 20 November 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

Waiting times in Gradina/Kalotina have decreased from the previous week maximum. Horgos/Roszke, on the other side, have experienced longer waiting times but still below the monthly average (especially for the SRB – HUN direction). Batrovci/Bajakovo has seen substantial improvement on the SRB – HR direction, but waiting times on the opposite direction have increased. Waiting time have been also increasing in Kakavija/Ktismata, while for the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
