

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (2 - 6 November 2020)

### BORDER MONITORING

In the first week of November the worsening trend in Gradina/Kalotina, Horgos/Roszke and Kakavija/Ktismata continued. In particular, Horgos/Roszke has experienced highest waiting times since the commencing of the monitoring exercise on SRB – Hungary direction. On the opposite side, waiting times in Batrovci/Bajakovo have slightly decreased.

For the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained stable.

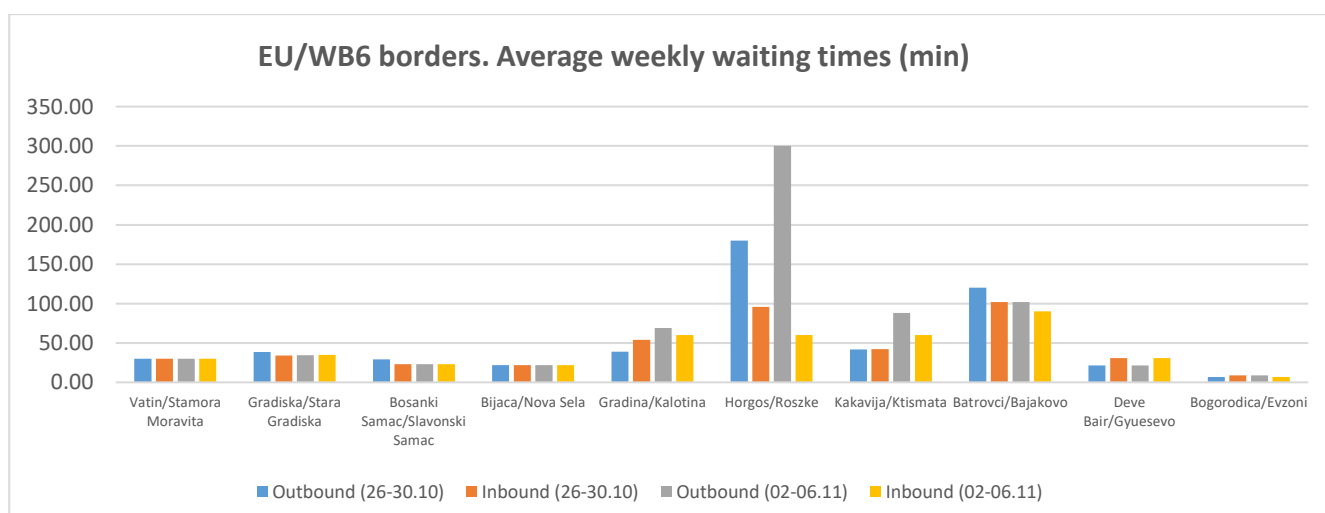


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
