

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (26 - 30 October 2020)

### BORDER MONITORING

The last week of October has brought prolonged waiting times on 4 of the monitored BCPs (Gradina/Kalotina, Horgos/Roszke, Kakavija/Ktismata and Batrovci/Bajakovo), with the most significant increase being in Horgos/Roszke.

For the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained stable.

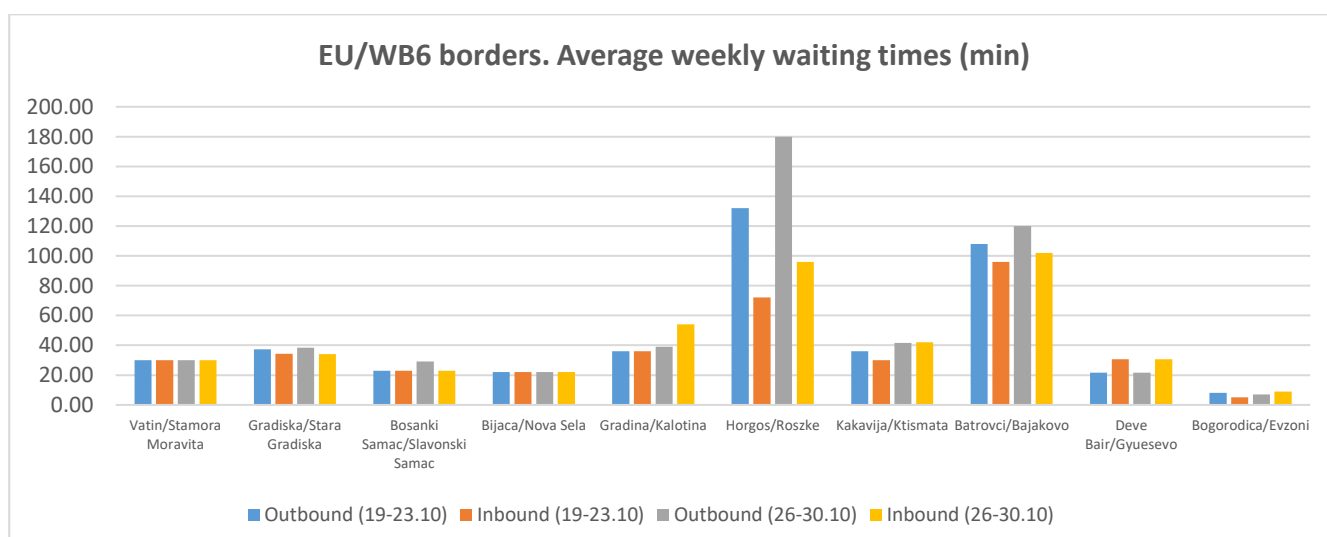


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
