

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (9 - 13 November 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

The second week of November has brought a spectacular improvement in Horgos/Roszke from the longest waiting times registered so far during the week from the 2nd to the 6th November to one of the shortest. Equally spectacular, though, was the increase in waiting times in Gradina/Kalotina where the worsening trend already visible last week seems to be accelerating. Kakavija/Ktismata seems to have returned to normal waiting times while for the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation has remained stable.

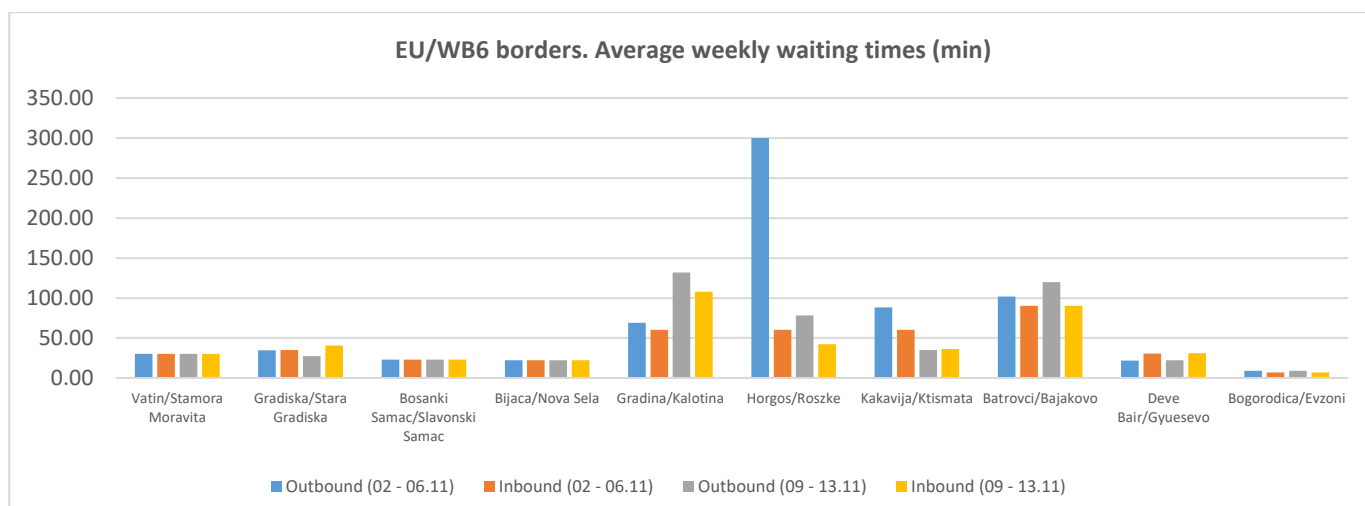


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
