

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (07 – 11 December 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke experienced the fifth consecutive week of worsening, coming close to the record registered in early November. Waiting times also increased in Gradina/Kalotina while a moderate increase on SRB-HR direction in Batrovci/Bajakovo was compensated by comparable improvement on HR-SRB direction. Kakavija/Ktismata went slightly better, while for the rest of EU/WB6 border crossing points under monitoring the situation remained stable.

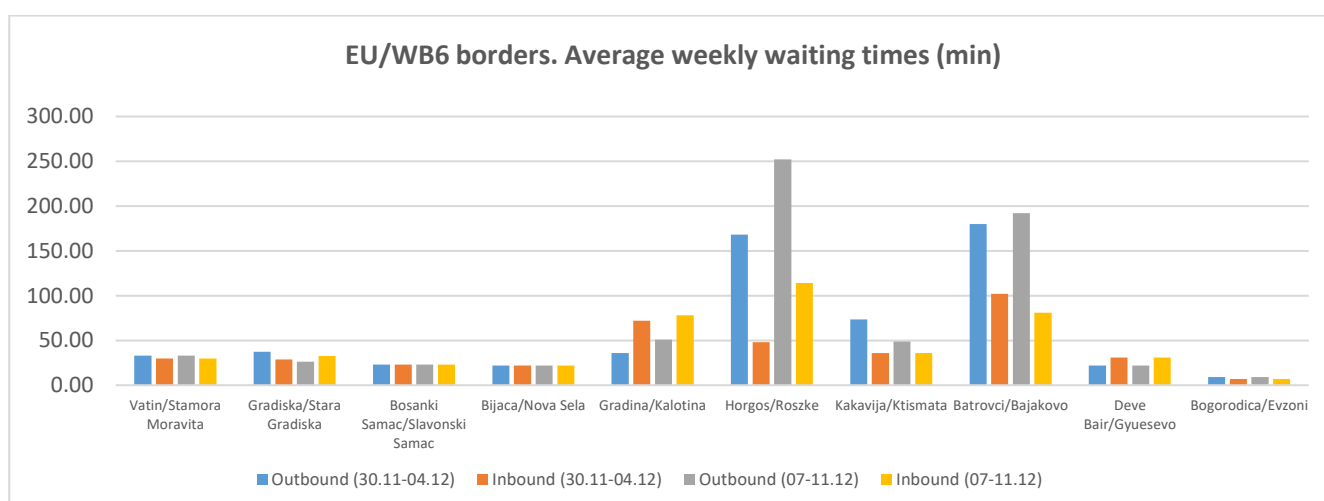


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
