Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (14 – 18 December 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

Situation in Horgos/Roszke have kept worsening for the sixth week in a row, hitting an all-time high record. Gradina/Kalotina have also experienced sharp worsening, becoming the second most crowded BCP in the region. Batrovci/Bajakovo went better on SRB-HR direction but significantly worse on HR-SRB. Kakavija/Ktismata was also on a worsening trend, while for the rest of EU/WB6 border crossing points under monitoring the situation remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
