

Monitoring of Western Balkans internal borders Weekly overview (14 - 18 December 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

During the third week of December (14 - 18 December 2020), the situation has remained stable at almost all internal BCP/CCPs, with the exception of **Sremska Raca/Raca** where a significant increase of waiting time has been noticed on SRB-BIH direction.

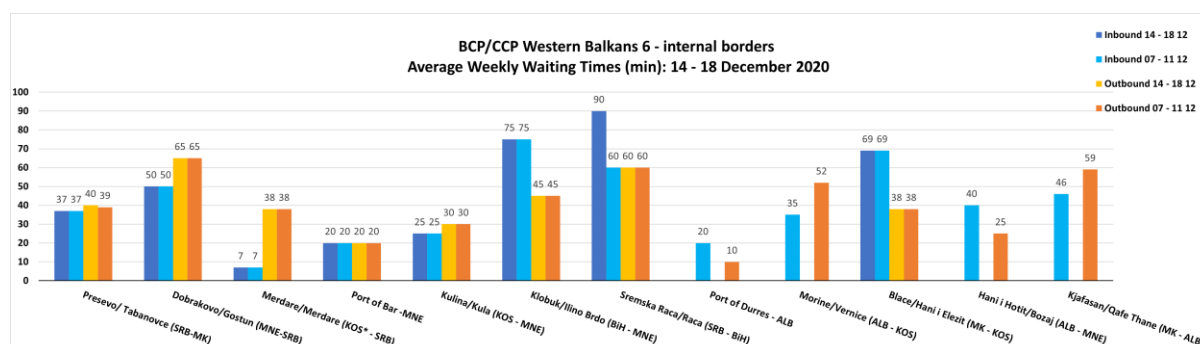


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
