

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (23 - 27 November 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

Waiting times in Gradina/Kalotina kept improving for the second week in a row. In Horgos/Roszke, for the first time since the starting of the monitoring exercise, waiting times on HUN-SRB direction were longer than on SRB - HUN. Batrovci/Bajakovo experienced a substantial increase on the SRB – HR direction while Kakavija/Ktismata went better. Waiting times in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska slightly increased, while for the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation remained stable.

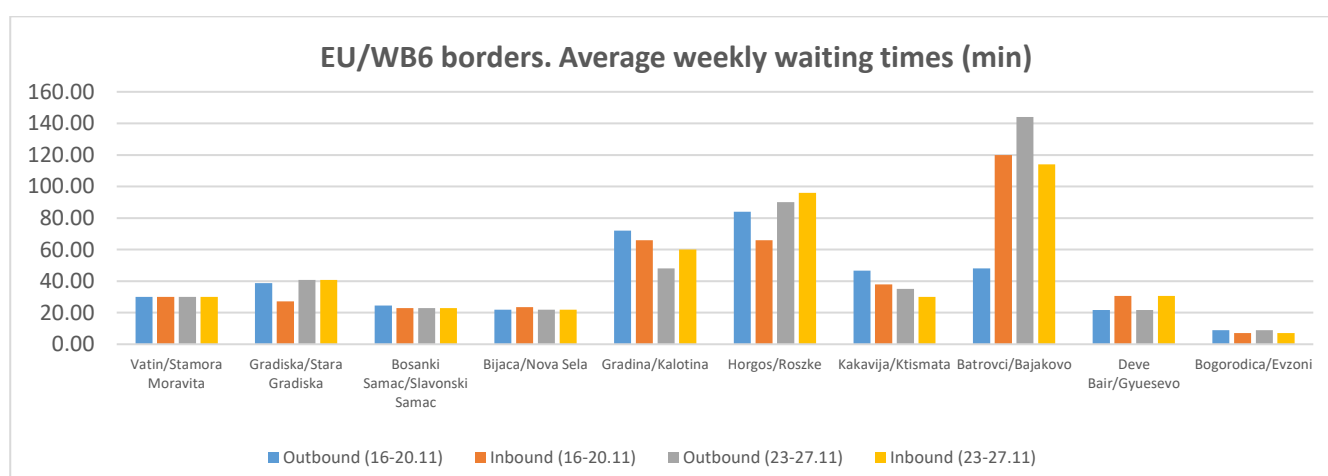


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
