

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (30 November – 04 December 2020)

BORDER MONITORING

The first week of December came with increased waiting times in Kakavija/Ktismata and Batrovci/Bajakovo (despite a slight improvement on HR – SRB direction). Same happened in Horgos/Roszke, where the improvement on HUN-SRB direction was not enough to compensate the sudden increase on SRB – HUN. Waiting times in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska slightly decreased, while for the rest of the EU/WB6 Border Crossings in the region the situation remained stable.

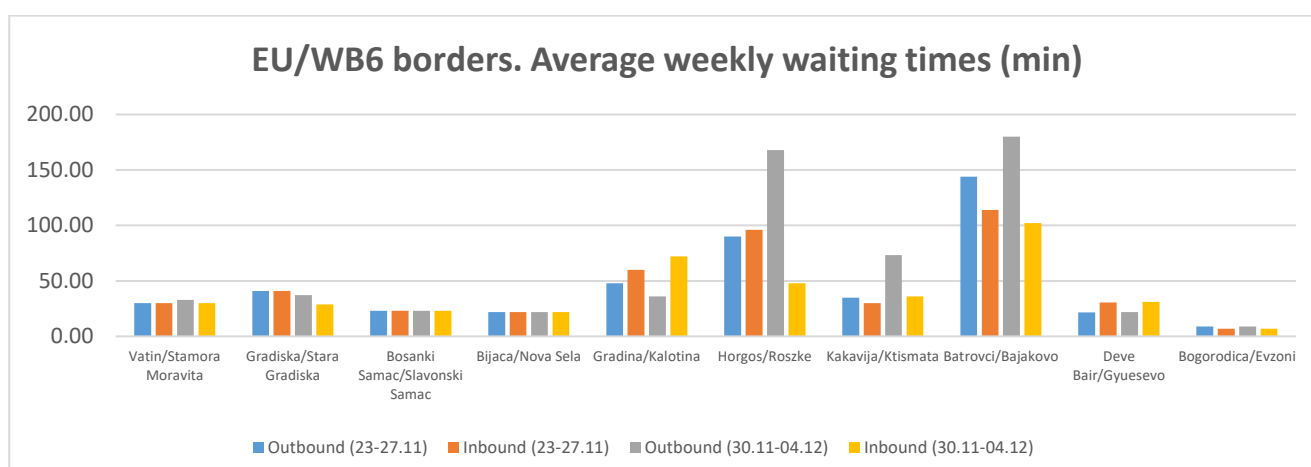


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
