

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 land borders Weekly overview (04 – 08 January 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

The first week of the year has brought mild traffic conditions and lower than average waiting times at most WB6/EU borders under monitoring with the sole exception of Gradina/Kalotina, where the situation has slightly worsened as compared with last week. Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo have remained close to the last week's record low. However, it is expected traffic to return to normal in the coming period.

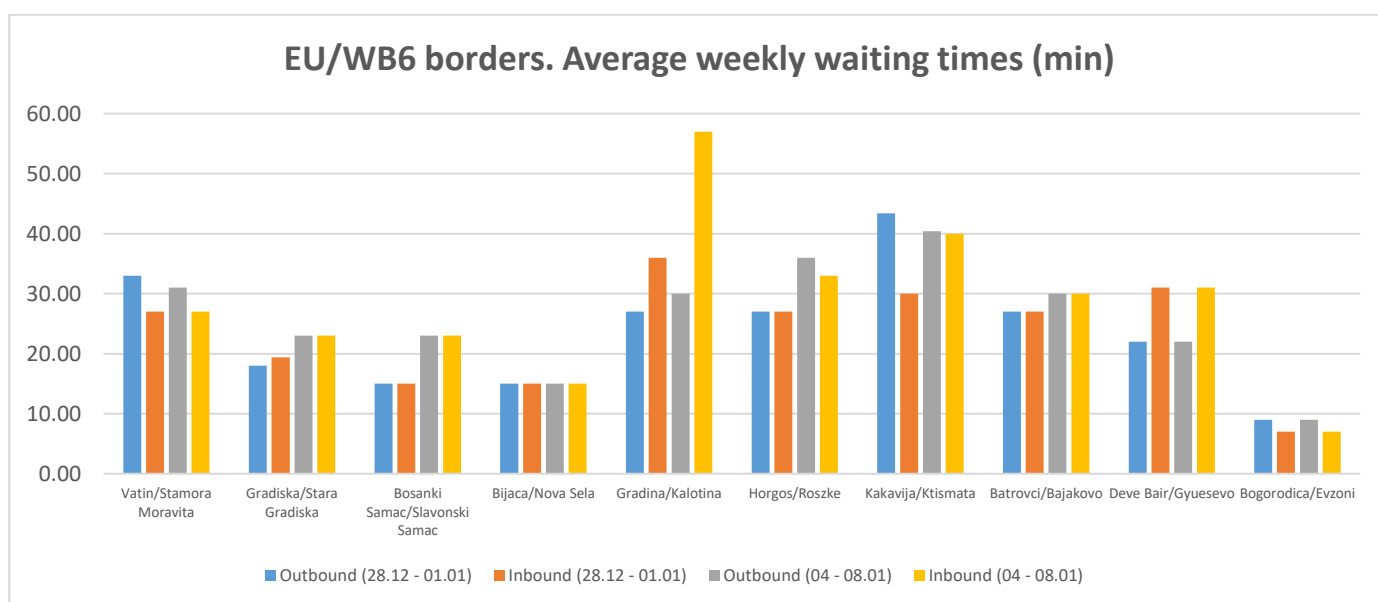


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
