

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (18 - 22 January 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

There were no spectacular evolutions recorded, but rather slightly variations this week. Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradina/Kalotina and Batrovci/Bajakovo went slightly better while in Kakavija/Ktismata waiting times have increased. A significant decrease in waiting time on SRB-HUN direction in Horgos/Roszke was balanced by similar increase on HUN – SRB. For the other BCPs under monitoring the situation has remained stable.

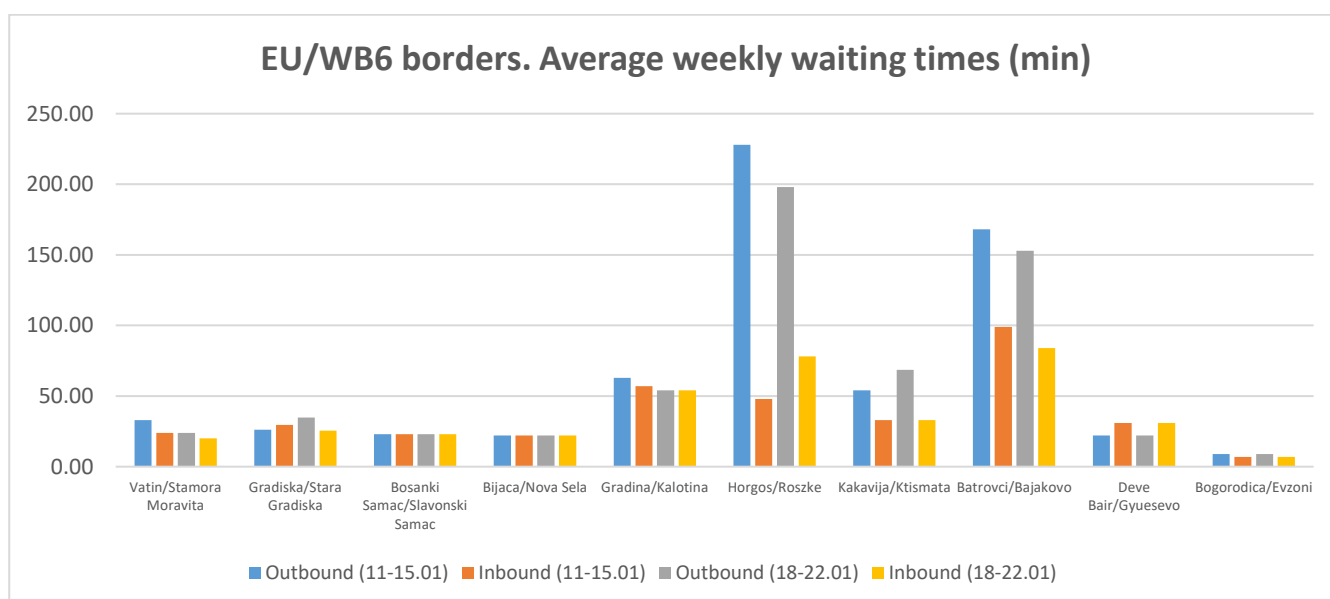


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
