

## Monitoring of Western Balkans internal borders Weekly overview (15 - 19 February 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

During the third week of February (15 - 19 February 2021), the situation has remained stable at almost all internal BCP/CCPs. Only Sremska Raca/Raca BCP is experiencing worsening (+38min) in SRB-BIH direction.

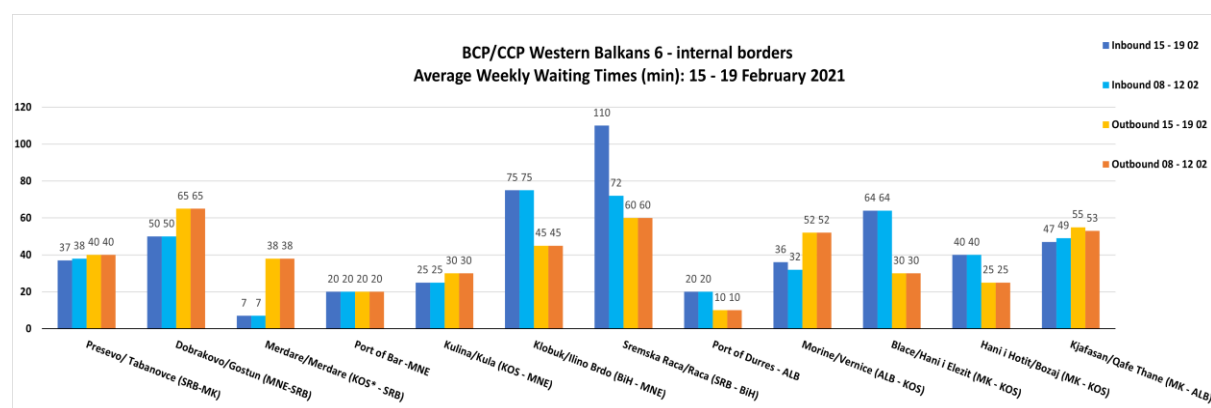


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
