BORDER MONITORING

During the last week of January, waiting times decreased in Gradina/Kalotina, Horgos/Roszke and Kakavija/Ktismata. In the meantime, situation turned slightly worse in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska (HR – BiH direction) and much worse in Batrovci/Bajakovo (SRB-HR) were unofficial claims of waiting times up to 24 h were made. For the other BCPs under monitoring the situation has remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
