

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (08 – 12 February 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke have experienced the shortest waiting times since the winter break period. Waiting times have been particularly low on SRB-HUN direction (traditionally the most crowded). Kakavija/Ktismata witnessed slightly longer waiting times on both directions, while for the other BCPs under monitoring the situation has remained more or less stable.

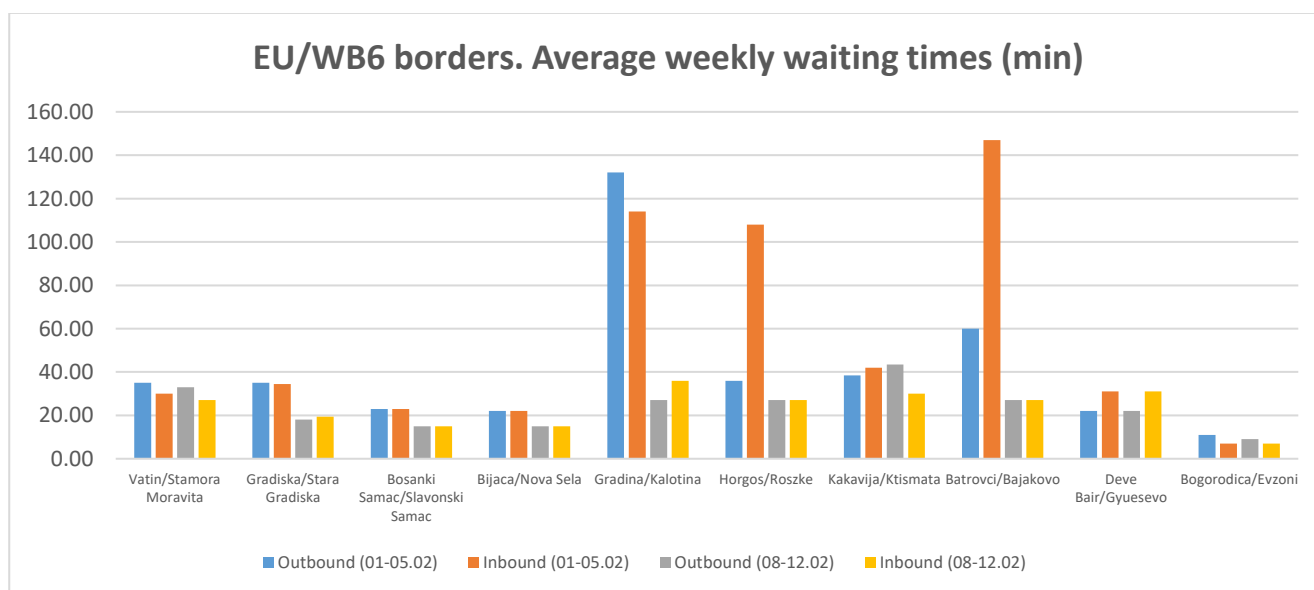


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
