Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (08 – 12 March 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Border waiting times have slightly increased in Vatin/Stamora Moravita (SRB – RO direction) and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac (HR – BiH direction). Slight decrease has been recorded in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska on BiH – HR direction. In Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo waiting times have increased substantially, especially towards the EU. Kakavija/Ktismata has returned to normal after last week's peak, but Bogorodica/Evzoni has kept reporting higher than usual waiting times on both directions.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
