BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke remained more or less stable (with SRB-HUN improving and HUN-SRB worsening), while Batrovci/Bajakvo went significantly better. Waiting times increased in Gradina/Kalotina and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac (BiH – HR direction) while slight improvement was noticed in Vatin/Stamora Moravita. Bogordica/Evzoni remained stable but average reported figures should be taken cautiously, as not fully reflecting the situation from the drivers' perspective




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
