

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (12 – 16 April 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

After the previous weeks' record values, week from 12 to 16 April brought significant improvements that were mostly visible in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo. Waiting times also decreased on BiH – HR direction, in both Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac and Gradiska/Stara Gradiska. Bogorodica/Evzoni seems to be also returning to normal.

In all other BCPs under monitoring waiting times remained mostly stable.

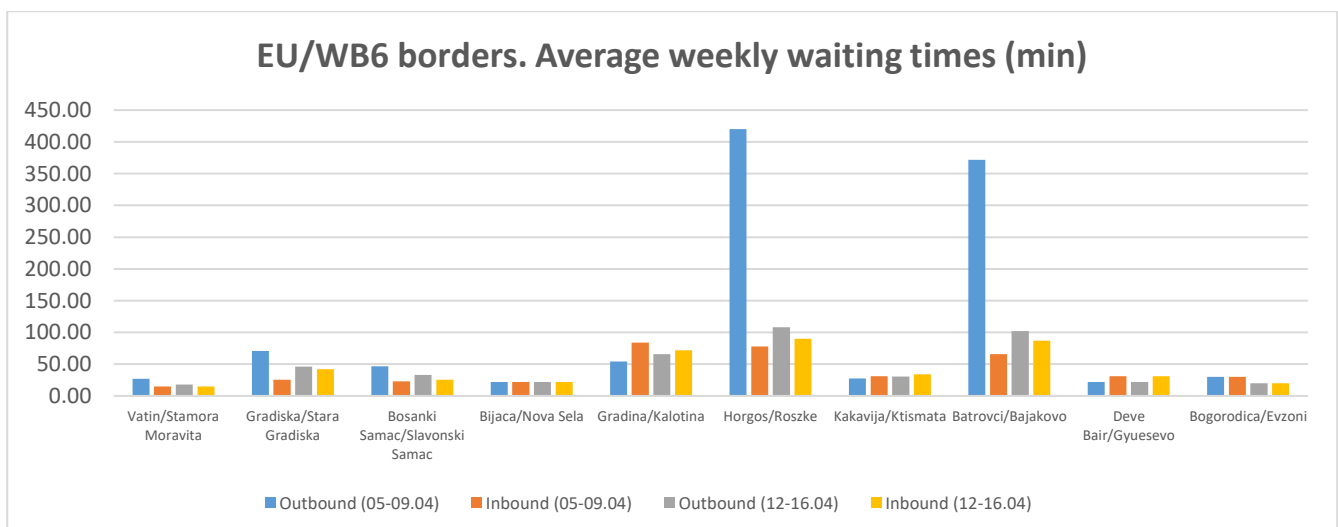


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
