

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (19 – 23 April 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Situation got better at BiH – HR border, as waiting times decreased on both directions in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac. On the contrary, waiting times increased significantly in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo towards HUN and HR respectively. While there was also a slight decrease towards SRB, the situation in these BCPs was on a worsening trend. Same happened in Kakavija/Ktismata, where waiting times increased on both directions while in Gradina/Kalotina longer waiting on BG – SRB direction was compensated by comparable improvement on the opposite side. All other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

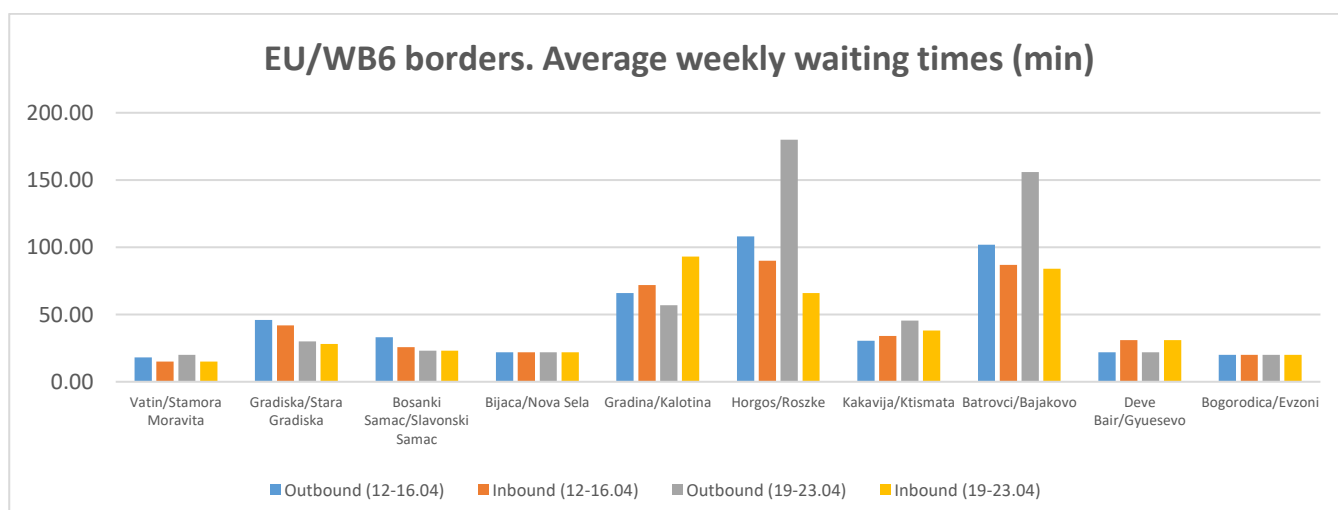


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
