

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (03 – 07 May 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Early May Holidays brought significant improvements for nearly all Border Crossing Points under monitoring. Most spectacular decrease in waiting times was witnessed in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo (usually the most crowded BCPs between WB6 region and the EU), with the latter coming close to its all-time low records in late December/early January. The only slight increase in waiting times was recorded in Kakavija/Ktismata on EL-ALB direction, but this was fully compensated by a significant improvement on the opposite side (ALB-EL).

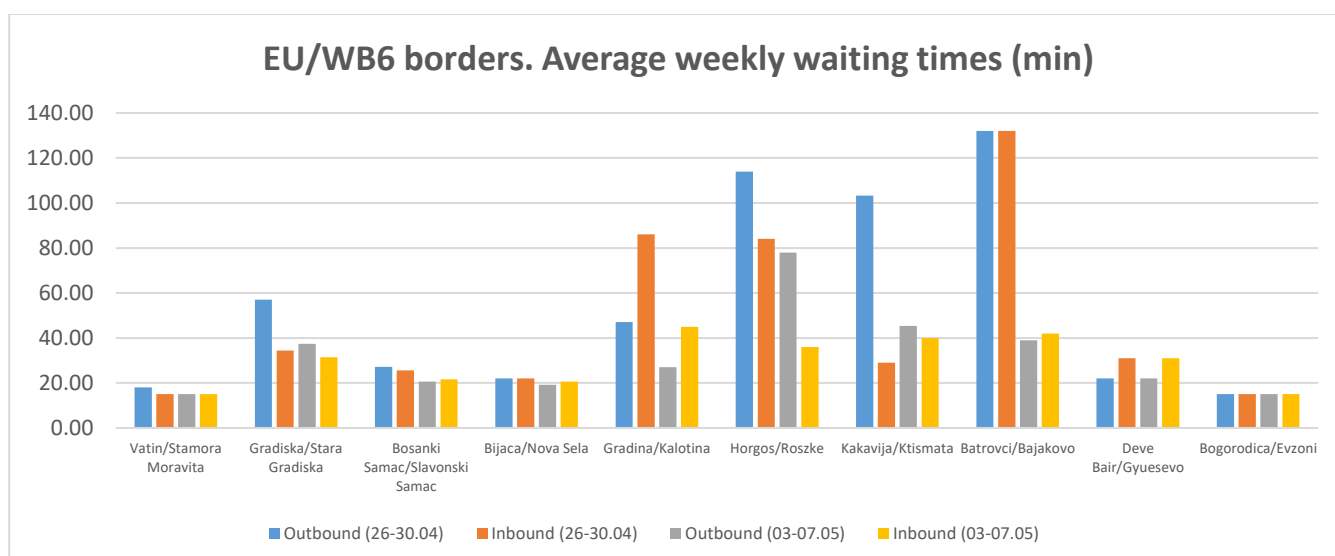


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
