

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (26 – 30 April 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

The last week of April brought increased waiting times in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska, almost doubling on BiH – HR direction. The situation improved in Gradina/Kalotina and Horgos/Roszke despite a small increase on HUN – SRB direction. Waiting time increased also in Kakavija/Ktismata while all others BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

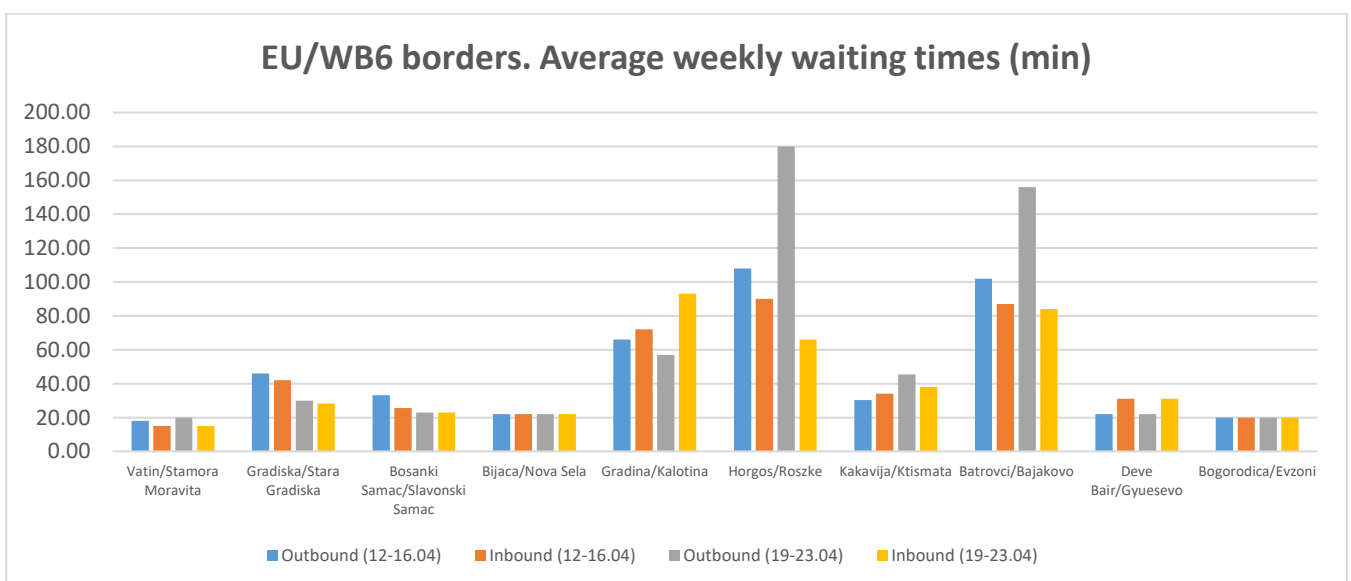


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
