# 4. Discussion on TAIEX trainings to be envisaged in the future and planning of applications



#### TDG related activities



- Establish a functional and coherent cooperation with the Regional Participants
- Make people aware about the needs of the sector
- WB6 faces a serious problem:
- lack of specialised human resources in administration
- overload in terms of work
- Awareness raising exercises and investments in capacity building are urgently needed

### Where should Regional Participants look for help?



- All Regional Partners are eligible for technical support provided by the Commission
- Depending on the maturity of their needs, the Regional Participants will request in the future assistance within <u>TAIEX</u> and <u>Twining</u> programmes
- Public officials of EU Member States with expertise relevant to TAIEX beneficiaries can register as <u>TAIEX experts or as institutional contact points</u>.

#### How can EU Member States/ experts help?



• Public officials of EU Member States with expertise relevant to TAIEX beneficiaries can register as <u>TAIEX experts or as institutional contact</u> points.

#### MOST important



- Coherence of activities should be ensured
- For certain activities financing can be secured from different sources
   OR
- It is possible that ADR/RID/ADN needs be addressed within "wider" financing programmes, within projects related to road safety for ADR or railway general legislation for RID
- TC PS can act as a facilitator, helping in putting the pieces of the puzzle together

#### Ongoing activities



#### 1) Kosovo(\*1) – Introduction to Directive 2008/68/EC (ADR and RID)

- The project will be a series of events dedicated to enhancement of knowledge and capacity building related to the above-mentioned legal instruments, i.e. Directive 2008/68/EC and its Annexes, as applicable— i.e. ADR and RID only.
- TBS if the training can be opened for other Regional Participants also.

#### Ongoing activities



#### 2) Serbia – Digitalization of examinations of DGSAs, ADR drivers and ADN experts

- TCPS is currently trying to help Serbia towards their end to move the examinations of DGSAs, ADR drivers and ADN experts from a paper-based activity to an online exam, where this is possible.
- A mix of IPA funding and eventually capacity building exercises is currently envisaged.
- Where language compatibility allows, Serbian Government considers opening this exercise to other interested Regional Partners.

#### Ongoing activities



- 3) Albania and/or Montenegro Training of emergency services concerning intervention in case of accident/incident involving dangerous goods
- This project should contain theoretical training on the Annexes to Directive 2008/68/EC, a screening of the existing resources of the emergency services of the Regional Partners and as soon as the current crisis will allow a site visit of EU Member States relevant emergency services to better understand how emergency response should be organized to efficiently prevent manmade disasters.
