

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (21 – 25 June 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

After last week's peak Horgos/Roszke went better on both directions. An improvement was also noticed in Gradina/Kalotina (particularly on BG-SRB direction). Overall, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac went also better, despite slight increases being registered on one direction. Vatin/Stamora Moravita experienced slightly increased waiting times. Batrovci/Bajakovo went also worse despite a slight decrease in waiting times on SRB-HR direction, as on the opposite direction situation turned much worse (waiting times almost doubled). All the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

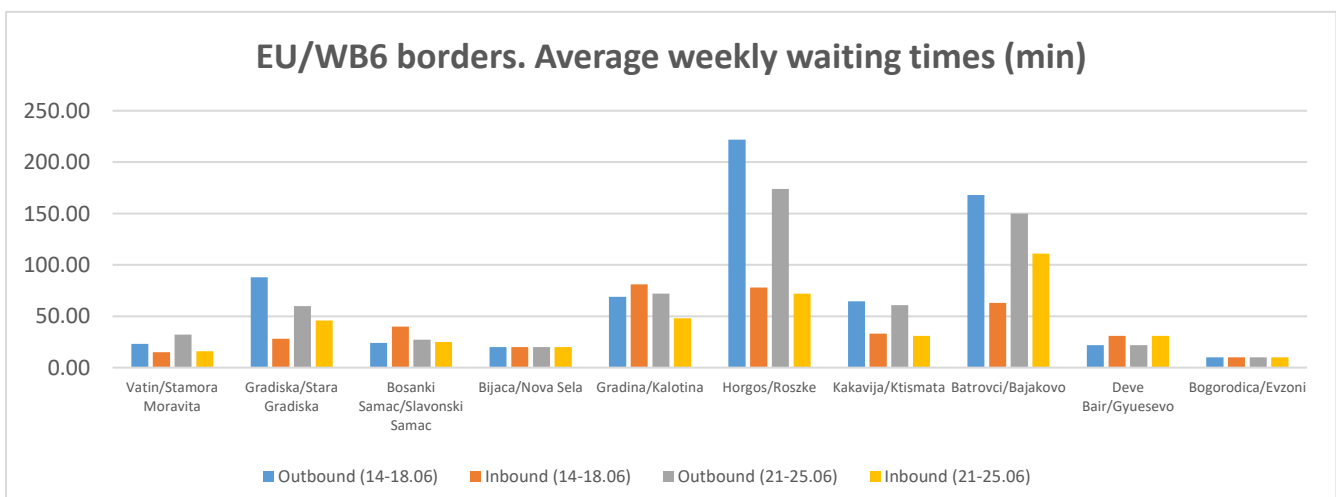


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
