

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (07 – 11 June 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

With the sole exception of Horgos/Roszke who experienced slight increase on both directions, all the other BCPs under monitoring either improved or remained stable. In Batrovci/Bajakovo waiting times increased on SRB-HR direction, but such trend was compensated by comparable decrease on the opposite side. Vatin/Stamora Morvaita and Gradina/Kalotina improved, with the latter registering remarkable low waiting times on SRB-BG direction. For all the other BCPs under monitoring, waiting times remained stable.

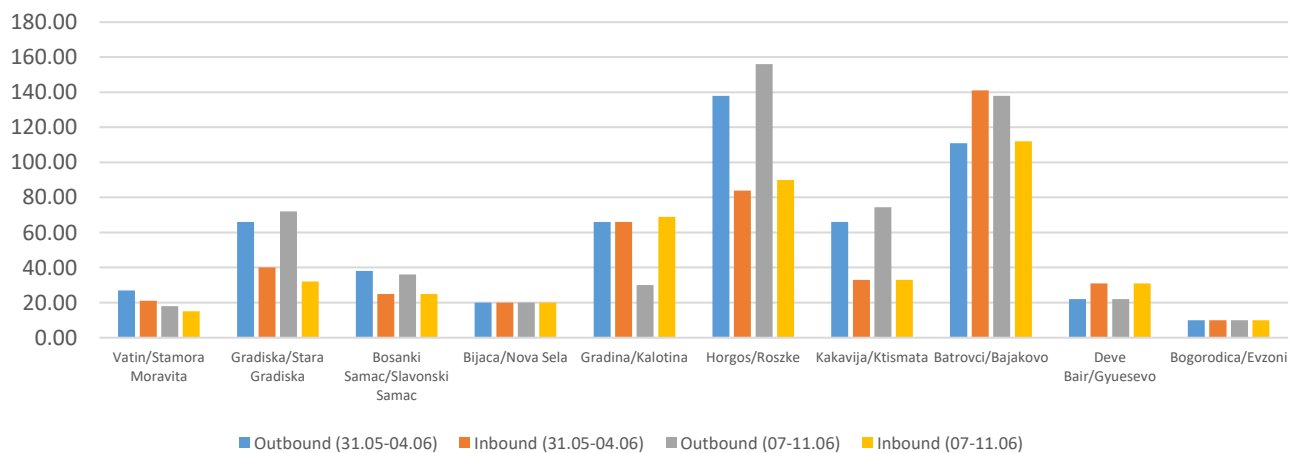


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
