

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (14 – 18 June 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went worse on BiH-HR direction, this being only partially compensated by a slight decrease in waiting time from HR to BiH. Waiting times increased significantly in Gradina/Kalotina on both directions. Average waiting times on SRB-HUN in Horgos/Roszke nearly hit 4 hours. Batrovci/Bajakovo and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac fluctuated significantly as compared to last week but were nevertheless labelled as stable (increase in waiting time on one direction was compensated by comparable decrease on the opposite side). For all the other BCPs under monitoring, waiting times remained stable.

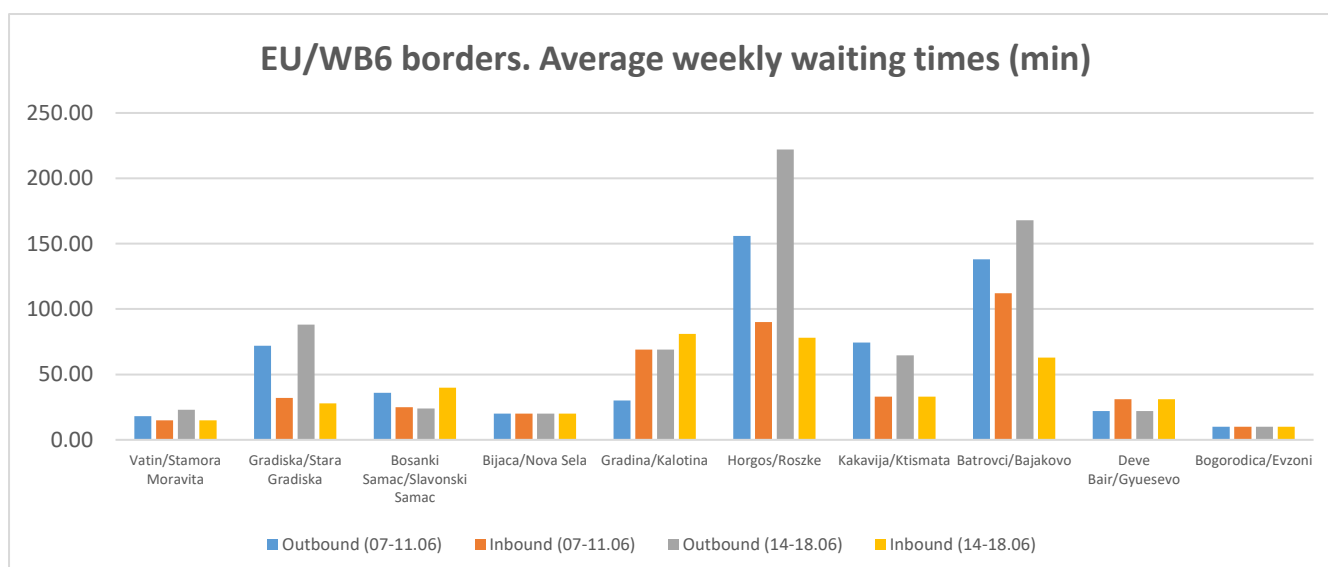


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
