

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (31 May – 04 June 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

The first summer week brought improvements in border waiting times across the region. The only BCP under monitoring where waiting times increased from the previous week was Vatin/Stamora Moravita, where trucks queuing is rare. Gradiska/Stara Gradiska, Gradina/Kalotina and Horgos/Roszke went significantly better. In Batrovci/Bajakovo waiting times increased on HR-SRB direction, but such trend was over-compensated by a significant decrease on the opposite side. For all the other BCPs under monitoring, waiting times remained stable.

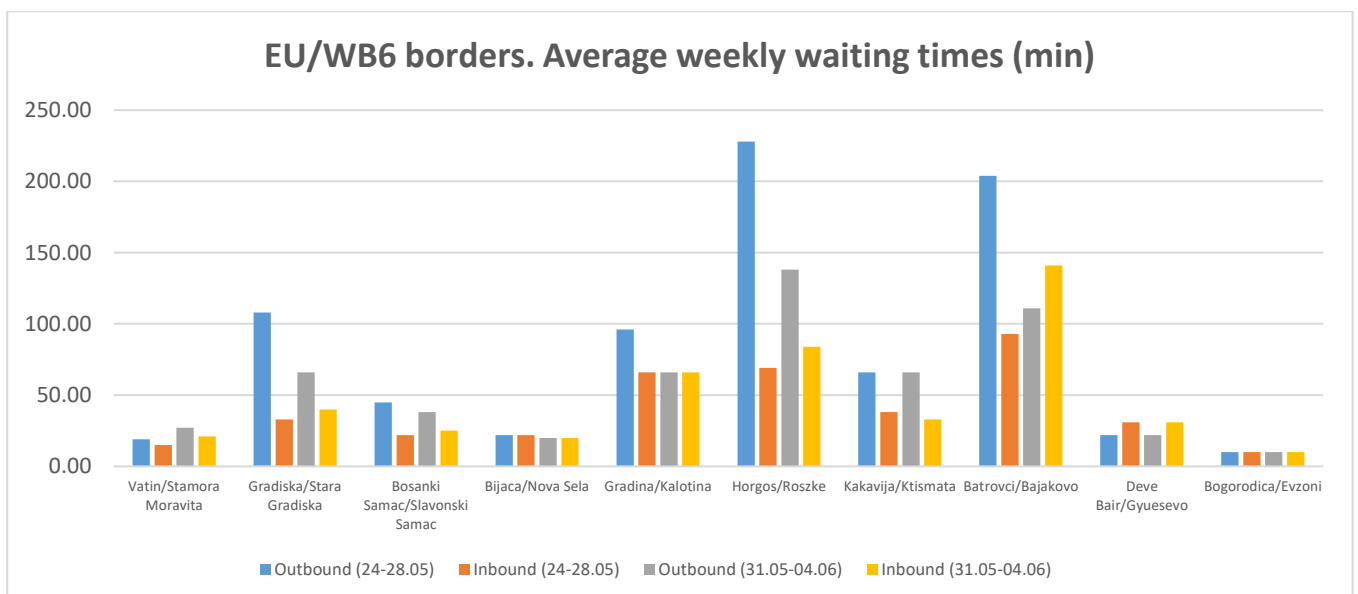


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
