

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (16 - 20 August 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Compared with last week figures, waiting times improved in Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradina/Kalotina (close to an all-time minimum) and Kakavija/Ktismata. Horgos/Roszke remained stable, close to overall average (but way below the last months' average figures for the SRB-HUN direction). Situation worsened in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska for the second week in a row, reaching an all-time high. Batrovci/Bajakovo also turned worse from last week record lows while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

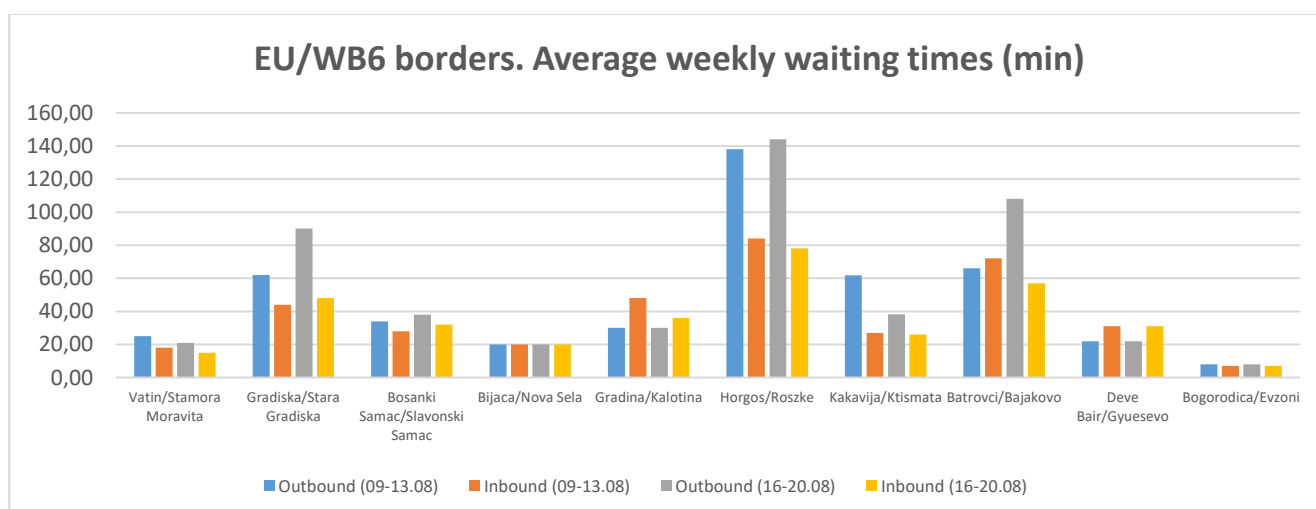


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
