

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (20 - 24 September 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac was the only of the monitored BCPs where slight improvement was noticed (more specifically on HR-BiH direction). Horgos/Roszke experienced sudden worsening with average waiting time exceeding 4h on SRB-HUN direction. After weeks of remarkably low waiting times, Gradina/Kalotina also turned worse. Waiting times were also increasing in Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Kakavija/Ktismata. All the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

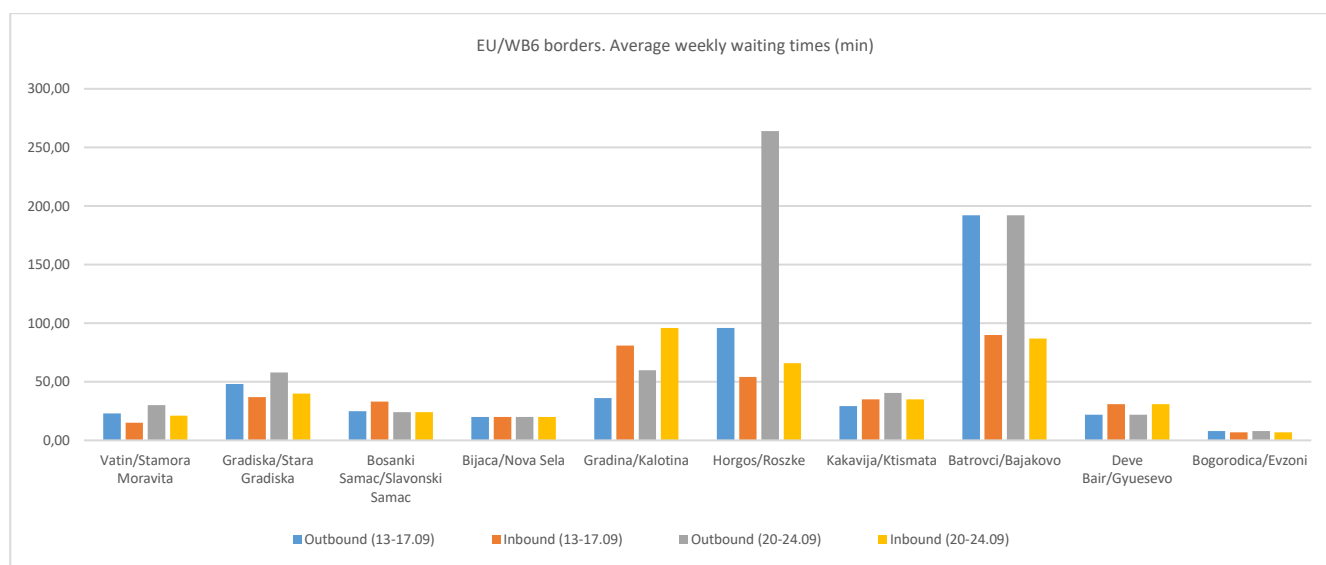


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
