Capacity building needs for firefighters

Overall Goal

Strengthening capacities of firefighters in order to enhance prevention, preparedness and response in case of manmade disasters in order to mitigate impact of climate change and protect people, material goods, environment and cultural heritage.

Specific Objectives

Improving capacities of firefighters in case of manmade disasters (technical and technological accidents, transport of dangerous goods...) and enhancing knowledge and expertise in the area of disaster risk reduction particularly through conducting training and exchange and transfer of knowledge and experiences.

Topics for Training of firefighters (proposal)

- basic characteristics of dangerous goods and their classification
- types of interventions in case of accidents with dangerous goods
- transport of dangerous goods / legislation
- means for transport of dangerous goods and packaging of dangerous goods
- basic elements and ways of identification of dangerous goods
- protection and safety measures during interventions with dangerous goods
- first aid in case of accidents with dangerous goods
- equipment for protection and intervention in case of accidents with dangerous goods
- basic procedures during the intervention with dangerous goods.

Purpose of the Activity

Education and training of firefighters on topics related to interventions of firefighters in case of accidents with dangerous goods as well as exchange knowledge and expertise in the area of technical and technological accidents.

Results

According to EU standards, trained firefighters would transfer their knowledge and skills to other firefighters in their units. They would use their knowledge and skills during the real interventions to safe and protect people, material goods, environment and cultural heritage.

Sustainability of the Project

Trained firefighters can possibility to transfer their knowledge and skills to other firefighters in their units and the best of them would be involved in the training process at the future National training center for rescue and protection as experts in this filed.
