BORDER MONITORING

Both Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo improved on SRB-EU direction, while registering slight increase in waiting times on the opposite side (in Horgos/Roszke it was one of the very few occasions when waiting times were longer on the inbound direction). Slight improvement was also noticed in Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac (mostly on the inbound direction). Vatin/Stamora Moravita and Gradina/Kalotina went worse while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
