

## Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (13 - 17 September 2021)

### BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke kept improving for the second week in a row, with waiting times on HUN-SRB direction almost halving. Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Kakavija/Ktismata also went better. Despite slight increase on BG-SRB direction, Gradina/Kalotina improved significantly on the SRB-EU side. Unlike Horgos/Roszke, Batrovci/Bajakovo went worse, with long waiting times being registered on SRB-HR direction. Slight worsening was also witnessed in Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

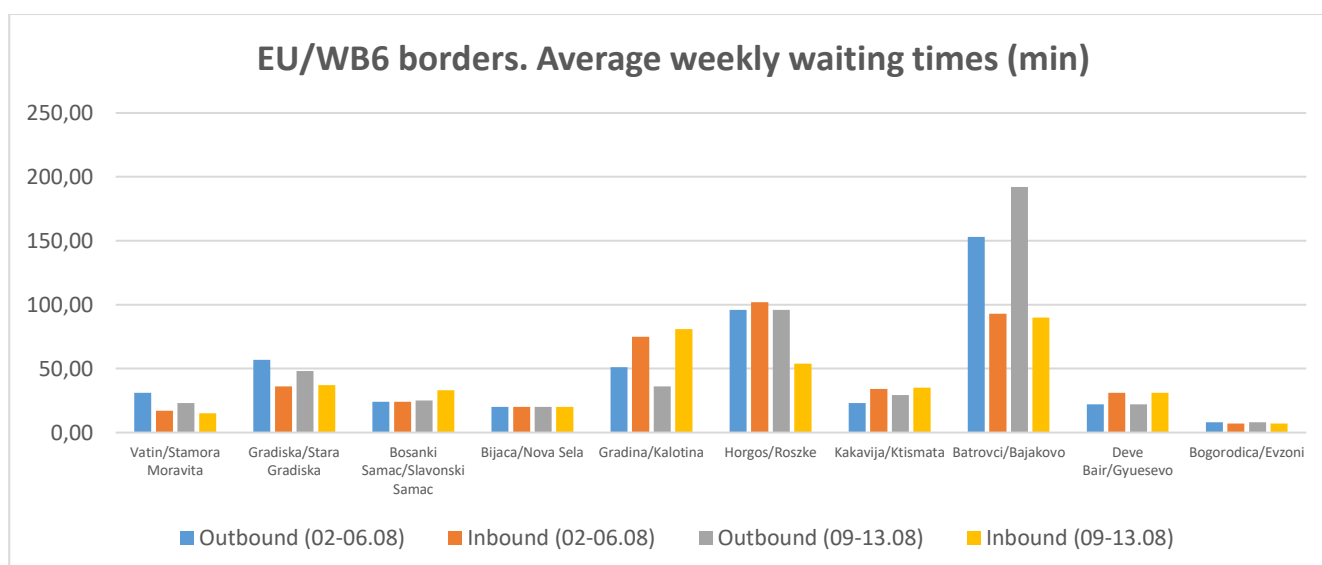


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
