BORDER MONITORING

Waiting times on the outbound direction improved in both Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo. The latter experienced, however, worsening on HR-SRB direction. Slight improvements were also recorded in Vatin/Stamora Moravita, Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac. Despite reaching record-low value on SRB-BG direction, Gradina/Kalotina turned worse, because of more significant increase on the opposite side. Waiting times increased on both directions in Kakavija/Ktismata, while the others BCP under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
