

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (30 August – 03 September 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

First days of the autumn brought increasing waiting times in Horgos/Roszke and Batrovci/Bajakovo. Gradina/Kalotin also turned to the worse, because of increased waiting times on BG-SRB direction. Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went better, but Bosanski Samac/Slavonski Samac experienced slight increase on HR-BiH direction. Kakavija/Ktismata turned better, while the others BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

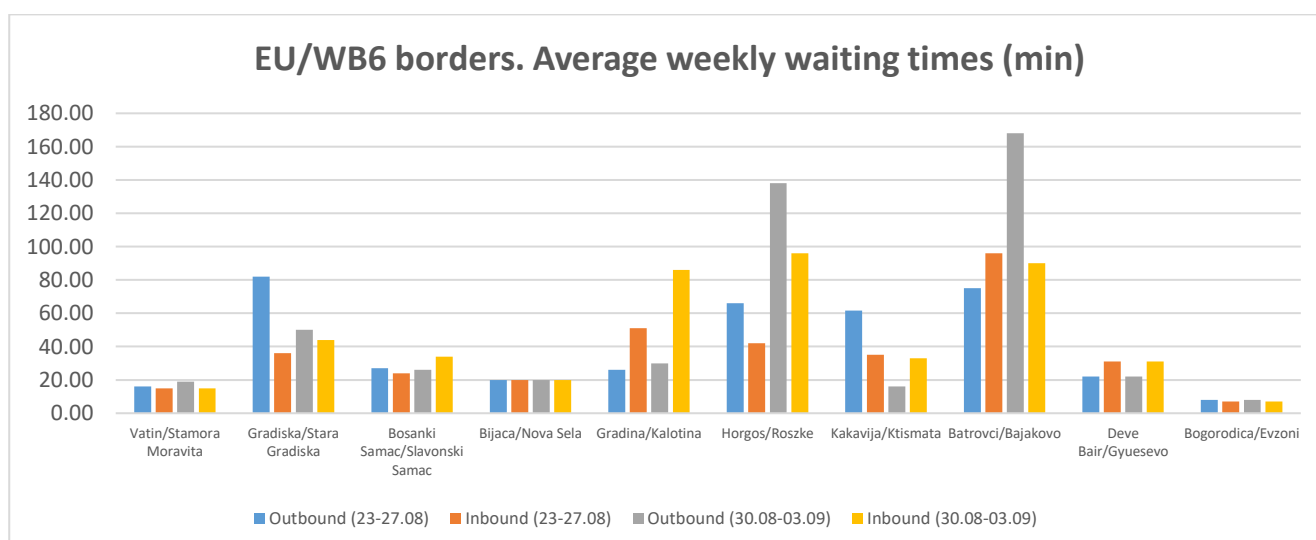


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
