2021 KPIs for RPs:

- ✓ Creation of the TDG implementation group chaired by the Members of the TDG Committee
 - ✓ Drafting of a Concept paper concerning the administrative structures to be put in place for transposition and implementation of Directive 2008/68/EC
- => presented at the next to Regional Steering Committee meeting - scheduled for 16 December 2021

Guidelines



- 2022 KPIs for RPs:
 - ✓ All Regional Partners will apply for initial training programmes dedicated to TDG
 - ✓ The TDG domestic implementation groups will report on their activities to the TDG Technical Committee
 - ✓ All Regional Partners will clarify the administrative structures to be put in place for transposition and implementation of Directive 95/50/EC and will consider developing common cross-border harmonised roadside checks on TDG

Most important task: prepare 2023 when the agreements will be amended.
