BORDER MONITORING

All major BCPs on Corridor X turned worse, with waiting times increasing in both directions. Horgos/Roszke came close to all-time record high in early April 2021 on SRB-HUN direction, with unofficial reports of waiting times exceeding 24 hours. In Batrovci/Bajakovo and Gradina/Kalotina waiting times were also well above average. Marginal improvements were recorded in Vatin/Stamora Moravita and Kakavija/Ktismata while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
