Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (04 - 08 October 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

In Horgos/Roszke waiting times plummeted on SRB-HUN direction from last week peak to a value close to all time record low. On the other hand, idle times increased sharply on HUN-SRB direction, almost doubling from last week average. Same trend (though less blatant) could be observed in Batrovci/Bajakovo where waiting times decreased significantly on SRB-HR direction, while increasing on the opposite side. Gradina/Kalotina was turning better on BG-SRB direction, but much worse on SRB-BG. Gradiska/Stara Gradiska and Kakavija/Ktismata also experienced slight worsening, while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
