BORDER MONITORING

Despite significant increase in waiting times on SRB-HUN direction from last week minimum, Horgos/Roszke was marked as improving, due to the plummeting waiting times on HUN-SRB side. Same trend was observed in Batrovci/Bajakovo, but the overall situation there worsened, as the increase on SRB-HR direction was not compensated entirely by improvements on the other side of the border. Gradina/Kalotina kept worsening on both directions. Gradiska/Stara Gradiska was slightly improving on BiH-HR direction while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
