

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders

Weekly overview (18 - 22 October 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke turned worse, with waiting times on SRB-HUN direction increasingly steadily. Batrovci/Bajakovo remained relatively stable, slight improvements on SRB-HR side being compensated by comparable worsening on the other side of the border. Vatin/Stamora Moravita turned worse on SRB-RO direction while in Gradina/Kalotina waiting times plummeted on SRB-BG direction from previous weeks record high, marking a significant improvement. Gradiska/Stara Gradiska went also better, while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.




Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
