

Monitoring of EU/Western Balkans 6 TEN-T land borders Weekly overview (25 - 29 October 2021)

BORDER MONITORING

Horgos/Roszke kept worsening on both directions, coming close to all-time highs. In Batrovci/Bajakovo experienced slight improvement on HR-SRB direction, but waiting times remained nevertheless high on the opposite side (4 hours in average). Sudden worsening was witnessed in Gradiska/Stara Gradiska (especially on BiH-HR direction) and Gradina/Kalotina (on SRB side of the border). Vatin/ Stamora Moravita returned to normal, while the other BCPs under monitoring remained stable.

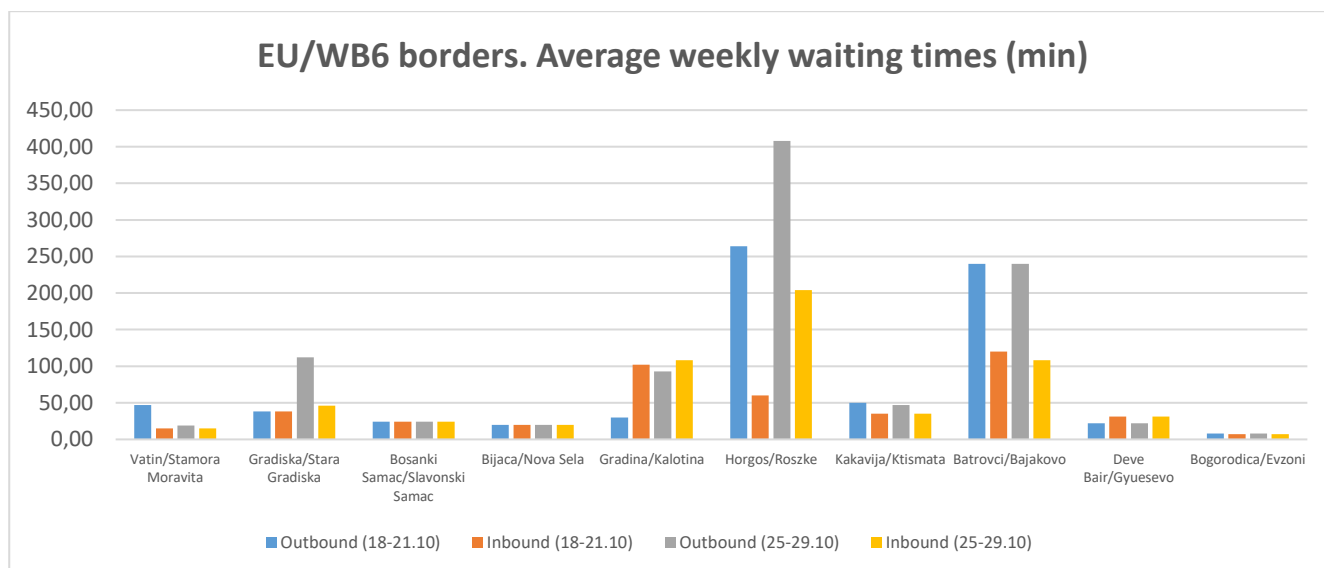


Figure 1: Average weekly waiting times (consecutive weekly trends)
